Meeting at Xian for the Formation of the International Consortium of Chinese Mathematicians

A meeting for the formation of the International Consortium of Chinese Mathematicians was convened from June 3 2015 to June 4 2015 at the beautiful city of Xian.¹ Over forty Chinese mathematicians from different regions of the world attended the 2-day meeting. A draft of the by-laws of the proposed Consortium was presented and discussed. From input given by the participants, the by-laws were revised, and circulated to all participants of the meeting in July 2015.

15th Anniversary of IPAM

The Institute of Pure and Applied Mathematics (IPAM) commemorated its fifteenth anniversary on October 6, 2015. The commemoration program began with brief talks by Prof. Al Hales, chairman of the board, and Prof. Russ Caflisch, Director of IPAM. These were followed by three talks given by young mathematicians, on themes related to the general subject of data analysis. The three speakers were all repeat-participants of programs and workshops at IPAM, and all attested to the benefits they had gained from IPAM's academic programs. IPAM was recently awarded its third renewal of five-year funding from the National Science Foundation.
