

TSINGHUA SANYA INTERNATIONAL MATHEMATICS FORUM



The Tsinghua Sanya International Mathematics Forum is a conference center on the island of Hainan in the South China Sea, where scientific meetings in mathematical sciences and related fields have been held since 2013. It was founded in June 2010 through an agreement between Tsinghua University, Hainan Province, and the Sanya Municipal Government to establish an international conference center reminiscent to Oberwolfach in Germany or Banff in Canada.

In the past 10 years, the forum has hosted 150+ international conferences with almost 8,000 participants and 4,160 invited lectures in disciplines ranging from pure and applied mathematics, statistics, physics, biology, computer science and aerospace. The forum has also actively contributed to science education in Hainan Province and the city of Sanya. Initiatives such as winter and summer camps for primary school students, lectures on university entrance exams for secondary school students and training courses for school principals and teachers underline the forum's commitment to local educational development.

Located in the tropical paradise of Hainan Island, a region known for its breathtaking landscapes and vibrant culture, the conference center consists of a spacious

campus with 17 buildings with 120 room and 36 apartments on an area of 29,400 square meters. It state-of-the-art facilities also features, a library, Chinese and Western restaurants, a swimming pool, a gymnasium and sports fields.

Often referred to as “China’s Hawaii”, Hainan is the country’s southernmost province, known for its lush greenery, pristine beaches and a climate that invites visitors to indulge in the warmth all year round. Sanya, the city hosting the forum, is famous for its azure waters, white sandy beaches and tropical ambience, has become a popular tourist destination that attracts visitors from all over the world.

This December marked the 10th anniversary of the establishment of Tsinghua Sanya International Mathematics Forum (TSIMF). An anniversary conference will be held in Sanya, Hainan Province during December 13–15 2023.

The three-day conference aims to review the development of the Sanya Forum in the past ten years and jointly look forward to the development of the next ten years.

INTERESTED IN VISITING TSIMF?

Due to the special status of the island, entering Hainan from abroad or through Hongkong is visa-free for international participant from 59 countries, including the US and EU, with a maximum stay of 30 days, see <https://en.hainan.gov.cn>.

Conferences of varying length and scale in the field of mathematical sciences can be hosted at TSIMF. Though the standard format is a one week conference with around 50 participants, the maximum capacity is around 150 people. For domestic conferences the local expenses at TSIMF need to be covered the attendees.
